Please use the following list as a guideline to prepare for the Beaver County Career & Technology Center Graduation Ceremony that will take place on **Friday, May 27, 2022, at 12:30 PM, at the CCBC Dome.**

- Students are to arrive at the CCBC Dome by 12:00 PM and should locate and join their instructor immediately.
- Ceremony begins promptly at 12:30 PM.
- Dress** - Students are to wear the cap and gown that they receive from their home school.
  - However, if you do not have a cap and gown, see Mr. Laderer (Math Teacher) at the CCBC Dome by 12:00 PM and he will provide one for you. **Gowns are limited.**
- All students **must** have a cap and gown. **If this is an issue, please see Ms. DelVecchio prior to graduation.**
- The CTC does not provide bussing to the Dome. If you are unable to find transportation, please make sure that the student's home school principal/counselor is aware of this.
- Handicapped parking - If you need parking close to the entrance of the CCBC Dome, plan to arrive early.
- There is no limit as to the number of guests the student may invite.

***However, if students have an outstanding debt of any sort, their grades and graduation packet, including diploma, will be held until the debt is settled. In addition, your home school will be made aware of these debts.***

***Also, receipt of this letter does not necessarily imply that every student who reads this letter will graduate.***

***Important Note:***

During the ceremony, students will receive an empty diploma cover. At the conclusion of the ceremony, each student will receive a packet from their instructor. This packet includes their diploma, task list, certifications, NOCTI certificate, link to order a yearbook and possible other items. File this information in a safe place, as some students may need it for furthering their education, military registration, and future employment.

In addition, yearbooks are \$20 and will be available for purchase by way of a link that can be found on our website sometime after May 16th. There will also be a small postcard included in the student's graduation packet with purchasing instructions.
