- Students should log on at the start of each block.
- Teachers will be available for the entirety of the block.
- Teachers may have additional “office hours” available.

Assignments & Grading

- Teachers will post a weekly schedule of assignments, assessments, and due dates for the upcoming week in their individual Google Classroom sites.
- Students will have a minimum of 24 hours to complete each assignment, thus it is important that you check in to each class session every day.
- The same grading and late work policies apply as during in-person instruction.

Attendance & Absences

- You will be sent a daily calendar invitation for attendance purposes.
 - You have until 11:59 each day to check-in for daily attendance.
- Each student will fill out a weekly check-in form in PLT.
- Work is not a valid excuse for absences or missed work.
 - An asynchronous recording of your class will be available.
- Excuses are required when you miss school, even virtually. Unexcused absences will result in lost credit for any work from that day.
- Students with an excused absence have five days to make up missed work.
- Any assignments that were due during an excused absence are due the day the student returns to school.
